EXTENSION TO SURF COAST WALK IN ANGLESEA

The Great Ocean Road Coast Committee has continued its work on the Anglesea coastal walking track, with a new extension recently completed down to the Anglesea River.

Great Ocean Road Coast Committee Executive Officer, Mr David Clarke, said “This further extension of the surf coast walk provides a fantastic connection with the Anglesea River and Anglesea surf beach”.

“Residents and visitors can now enjoy a great coastal walk from the Anglesea River to Point Roadknight”.

A section of the walking track from the Anglesea Surf Club car park to the top of the hill was completed earlier this year by the Great Ocean Road Coast Committee. Already it has proved popular with residents and visitors.

Users can now enjoy views from the track looking over Anglesea surf beach and river and views from the lookout at the top of the hill.

The track has been sensitively constructed through native vegetation, which provides a screen from the adjacent Great Ocean Road.

Mr Clarke said “We would like to thank Anglesea Coast Action Group for their support for this walking track”.

“Coastal walking tracks are a fantastic community asset for our fantastic section of coastline”, said Mr Clarke.
