### **Community consultation on draft Lorne Foreshore Master Plan now open**

The Great Ocean Road Coast Committee (GORCC) has released the Lorne Foreshore Draft Master Plan for community input.

The draft master plan identifies works to improve the foreshore, considering accessibility, use, and enjoyment, and will guide management of the precinct over the next 10-15 years.

The plan has been informed by feedback from community and stakeholder consultation conducted over summer 2018/19 and in response to increased visitation pressure to the Great Ocean Road.

The key themes highlighted during the initial round of consultation included upgrading the Doug Stirling Walk, retaining public open space, new and upgraded facilities and improving path connectivity and accessibility.

GORCC is seeking community and stakeholder feedback on the Lorne Foreshore Draft Master Plan up until Sunday 25 August 2019.

To have your say on the plan, you can attend one of the following consultation sessions:

- **Wednesday 24 July, 10am-12noon:** Lorne foreshore - adjacent to SLSC carpark
- **Saturday 3 August, 2-4pm:** Lorne foreshore - adjacent to SLSC carpark
- **Wednesday 14 August, 5-7pm:** Melbourne - 8 Nicholson St, East Melbourne (DELWP office).
