Recipients of the 2018 Victorian Coastal Council Award for Education, GORCC's education activities are run by highlyskilled education professionals who hold years of experience and knowledge of this coastline. Experiential and engaging for students of all ages, our education programs incorporate modern day, historical, and traditional perspectives of the coast, and explore the amazing diversity of plants, animals and physical geography in our region. We can cater for all age groups. Lessons typically run for 1.5 hours, and we can facilitate up to 25 students per educator.

- Session type: From a once-off activity to multiple weeks, whole term, or even a year-long program, our Education team can work with you to design the best program for your students' needs.
- Session time and length: We understand different groups will have different time restraints and needs. With flexibility in session delivery times and session length, our staff will

discuss what time suits best and if you'd go for a one-hour session or longer.

 Session location: Managing the coastline stretching from Pt Impossible to Lorne, our 'coastal classrooms' provide a range of engaging, fun, authentic learning opportunities for students of all ages. Our team will work with you to choose the most suitable location taking into account specific requirements such as distance to travel or subject focus.
