# **CREATURE FEATURES**

This is a great activity for adults and younger children to work on together. You might choose to do just one page or use different creatures as inspiration for different sections. You can even make up your own extra pages: wherever your imagination and inspiration leads.

Can't print this page? Just use this as inspiration to create your own version. This could be on sheets of paper, in a scrapbook, on the pavement in chalk, however and wherever you want .

# What you will need

- Find an animal in or around your house this could be a beetle, butterfly, moth, possum, magpie, wattlebird or even a pet. You might even want to use a favourite animal toy or photo for inspiration.
- Something to take or draw pictures with (tablet, camera, scrapbook, pencils, chalk)
- Craft materials to fill in pictures. For example wool, cotton balls, string, sandpaper, material cut offs, pipe cleaners, leaves, dirt, feathers etc.
- Glue or sticky tape, scissors
- Internet or reference books (see the last page for a list of great online resources)




